The Victoria Hall Support Group is a group of volunteers working to plug the gap left by the withdrawal of funding for the Vic from South Lakes District Council.

Since the inception of the VHSG, footfall at the Hall has doubled to 25,000 in the current year. Of course, the building itself is old – we have about £9,000 of roof repairs to do after Christmas.

Our current projects are to fund a new kitchen for the Hall to make sure we can offer catering into the future, which could cost over £20,000.
